Fire Smart Program

Administration has contracted for hazardous tree removal from reserves 1 and 2 (the two most northerly ones). Work was completed during the last week of February. If anyone is aware of any dead or dangerously-leaning trees on any of the reserves, or on walkways to the reserves, please let Administration know so that they can be tagged for removal.

Contractors have cut logs into manageable lengths and have deposited them alongside the nearest street. Residents may take these for their own firewood, on a first-come, first-serve basis. Branches have been chipped and recycled as mulch.

East Route Electrical Transmission Line

The AUC has approved the West Route; this means that the East Route which was to pass near the Summer Village will not be considered further. Council had submitted a brief to the AUC opposing the East Route on environmental and aesthetic grounds.
