SUMMER VILLAGE OF LARKSPUR BY-LAW # 4/99

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF LARKSPUR, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVYING OF PENALTIES ON UNPAID TAXES

WHEREAS, sections 344 and 345 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994 and amendments thereto, provides that a Council of a municipality may, by by-law, require any or all taxes be payable on a certain day and may impose a penalty for the non-payment of the current taxes and any taxes remaining unpaid after December 31st of a year

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Larkspur enacts as follows:

THAT ON September 16 of each year and in each succeeding year, a penalty of fifteen percent (15%) shall be levied upon and added to any remaining unpaid current taxes, and

THAT, in the event of any taxes remaining unpaid after December 31st of a year for which they are levied, there shall be added thereto, by way of an additional penalty, fifteen percent (15%) on the 1st day of January and in each succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid.

THAT, any penalty imposed under this By-law shall be added to and remain to form a part of the unpaid taxes.

By-law No. 6 of the Summer Village of Larkspur is hereby rescinded accordingly.

This by-law shall come into force and effect upon the date of the third and final reading.
