A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF LARKSPUR IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ADOPT AN INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, ("the Act") enables municipalities to adopt an intermunicipal development plan;

AND WHEREAS an Intermunicipal Development Plan has been prepared for the Summer Village of Larkspur and Westlock County and the based on public input, studies of land use, development, and other relevant data;

AND WHEREAS, the foresaid Intermunicipal Development Plan describes the way in which the future development within the Plan Area may be carried out in an orderly and economic manner; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Larkspur in the Province of Alberta duly assembled and pursuant to the authority conferred on it by the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Summer Village of Larkspur and Westlock County Intermunicipal Development Plan attached hereto as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw is hereby adopted.
- 2. This Bylaw may be cited as "Summer Village of Larkspur and Westlock County Intermunicipal Development Plan."
- 3. This Bylaw may be amended by Bylaw in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended.
- 4. Should any provision of this Bylaw be found invalid, the invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into force upon receipt of its third and final reading.



I am concerned about the current location of the IDP and request that council strongly consider the impact of accepting the current IDP boundary.

Currently, the IDP boundary on the south side of the lake is acceptable. From the current north boundary of the IDP, I propose the boundary be expanded around the north side of the lake to include all parcels within 400m of the lake shore.

Ensuring development is carried out properly on part of the lake is negated when the other half is free to develop under their own requirements.





After reviewing the current proposal, we are aware that the boundaries only include a small portion of the lake and lake shore of Long Island Lake. We are STRONGLY opposed to the IDP and any development that takes place on the surrounding lands on Long Island Lake. This lake is very small and in my opinion is at or very near its maximum capacity for development. The lake is a hazard waiting to happen with all the boat traffic in the summertime.

If development goes ahead on the land that is up for sale at the north end of the lake a developer will essentially have the power to double the number of residences on this lake. That will increase pollution, boat and other watercraft traffic and make everyone's enjoyment of the lake substantially less enjoyable.

I sold my boat, lift and majority of my dock because of boat traffic, shoreline erosion from the high water and the wake from the speeding boats that come too close to the shoreline. It wasn't safe being on the lake and you could recognise the boats that didn't respect the rights of others- most weren't residents.

I have talked to numerous County taxpayers and not one wants this proposal to go ahead. I hope they also voice opposition to this flawed proposal.

As a lot owner at S.V. Of Larkspur I'm aware that it's necessary and occasionally beneficial to have discussions with the County and there are examples where these have been helpful to us.

I'm not sure why this latest meeting is deemed necessary but there seems to be some suggestion that we need to talk about future development of the lake. My feelings on this are as follows: I feel that for a lake the size of ours, there is already enough activity. By that I mean too many large boats, too many seadoos roaring around in circles, too many wake boards, too much fireworks firing off late at night etc. etc. all making too much noise. Do we really want to see more of this by creating more development? Who is benefiting? Certainly not the people that are here now. One of my biggest concerns is the effect of all of this on the environment, that is the health of our lake as well as the surrounding area. I've seen what's happened to lakes over parts of Albert. Pine Lake, Thunder Lake, Nakumun Lake, Lake Isle, and more. All deteriorated to the point where they are green by June every year forcing people to try and dispose of a property they used to value highly.
